

The Gray Baton



Custom Balanced – Dynamically Tuned Baton

The talent and demands of the students that have been twirling the all metal Gray Baton since 1976 has dramatically improved. To meet this challenge, I have changed the Gray Baton to a solid composite ball, which allows the dynamics (the difference between the balance point and the measured center point) to be accurately controlled and presently pre-set to $\frac{3}{4}$ ". The new Gray Baton is tighter, has less vibration, better balance and can be twirled with greater confidence.

The plating on the ball has been a challenge. Composite material is very difficult to plate, so the new ball is vacuum plated. The plating will not stay if it is dropped on a hard surface. The OSU Drum Majors use paint, dye, ink or nail polish to touch up the ball.

The unique, hand crafted Gray Baton is only available to a limited market and is produced solely for the purpose of maintaining the tradition of the prominent drum major baton.
